Contest Schedule and General Information

8:00–8:45 a.m. Student/Sponsor Check-In

- Upon arrival, check in at the registration tables inside the IUPUI Campus Center.
- Students with exhibits must check in and complete their exhibit set-up by 8:45 a.m.
- Students must check in BEFORE setting up their entries.
- Students with exhibits will need to find their assigned entry number, which will appear on their packet, and locate the corresponding table number or floor space in the exhibit area.
- After students have picked up their packets, they may take their entries to the assigned judging room.

9 a.m.–Noon Preliminary Judging (Room assignments will be available at the check-in tables)

Exhibits

- Exhibits must be set up by 8:45 a.m.
- Exhibit removal will begin at approximately 2 p.m. NHD is not responsible for exhibits left in the exhibit hall after 2 p.m.

Papers

- Students should bring a copy of their paper for reference.

Documentaries

- Computers with projectors will be provided; however, students are responsible for ensuring compatibility with standard equipment and are urged to bring their own equipment if necessary.
- Documentaries may play from hard drives, DVDs, USB drive or from the internet. Students are encouraged to bring multiple copies and formats of their projects.
- Projection screens will be provided.
- Students who bring their own equipment should set up and check equipment at least 15 minutes prior to their assigned judging time.

Performances

- Restrooms will be available for students to change into their costumes.

Noon Lunch Break

1–2 p.m. Second Round of Exhibit Judging

- Students are not present for the second round of judging in the exhibit categories.
- A list of exhibits making it to the second round will not be published.
- Only judges will be allowed in the exhibits area during runoff competition judging.

Public Viewing

- Documentary, website and performance presentations are open to the public throughout the day.
- Exhibit and paper presentations are not open to the public during judging of contest entries.
- Public viewing of exhibits is from noon to 1 p.m.
- Papers will be available for public viewing at tables in the exhibit area from noon to 1 p.m.

Lunch Suggestions

- Several fast food restaurants are located in the shopping center just two blocks north of the IUPUI campus on University Boulevard, between 10th and 11th Streets.

Driving and Parking Instructions to IUPUI campus

- Exit I-65 at the Dr. Martin Luther King Exit. At the bottom of the exit ramp, turn right onto 11th Street (one-way westbound), then left on University Boulevard and cross Michigan Street. The Campus Center, where check in and most of the day's events are located, is on the right, on the corner of University Boulevard and Vermont Street. Note below that the nearest parking garage is on Vermont Street, a one-way street, on the opposite side of the Campus Center.
- Parking–The nearest parking garage is located just west of the Campus Center on Vermont Street. To access this garage, proceed one block west, past University Boulevard, on Michigan Street, then turn left onto Barnhill Drive, and left onto Vermont Street. The Parking Garage is labeled “XB” on the IUPUI campus map and the Campus Center is labeled “CE.” Do not park in lots which require parking permits. While IUPUI Campus Police may let students unload projects and equipment in the parking lots and streets closest to the IUPUI Campus Center, they will issue tickets to unauthorized parked cars in permit lots.
