# PHILIP BEVAN (1811 PAPERS, 1836–1915

## **BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH**

Minister. Bevan was an English carpenter and sailor; immigrant to Charlestown, Clark County, Indiana (1843); student at Lane Theological Seminary, Cincinnati, Ohio (1846-1849); Presbyterian minister in Leavenworth (Crawford County), Byrneville (Harrison County), Martinsburg (Washington County), and other towns in southeastern Indiana.

### SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The papers include Bevan's letters, official documents, and financial papers, principally relating to his ministerial career (1846-1890); a diary (1836-1881); and Bevan's poems, novels, and other unpublished writings.
