BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Richard Hyatt (d. 1889) was a member of a prominent Daviess County family, which had a farm north of Washington. His father, Elisha Hyatt (1809-1885), was active in a number of business ventures. The last of these was the Hyatt, Leving Co. Bank, which failed in 1884.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

This collection, filling one manuscript box, contains legal records dated 1885-1896, in connection with the estate of Richard Hyatt (d. 1889). They are mainly affidavits and court records concerning the ownership of land north of Washington in Daviess County.
