BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Ralph T. Swank was a Captain in the 379th Bomb Squad and the 310th Bomb Group. He was born in Noblesville, IN in 1916, and enlisted into the Army on May 16, 1942. Swank enlisted for the duration of World War II, as well as an additional six months after the war. His parents Willard and Claire Swank had three children: Opal, Ralph, and Wilma. There were no more available records of him after the war.

The majority of the collection contains 110 letters from Captain Ralph T. Swank to his family members in Noblesville, IN from 1943–1945. The letters discuss various family and local affairs.
