BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

James F. Yeoman, of Ambia, Indiana, wed Lola V. Sowerwine, of Wilkinson, Indiana, on June 28, 1899. James was born on December 15, 1872 near Rensselaer in Jasper County, Indiana. His wife Lola was born September 30, 1877 near Cicero in Hamilton County, Indiana. The couple had one daughter, Hallie, who was born May 12, 1900 in Ambia, Indiana, and one son Delos. Hallie married Grover Cooley, of Tippecanoe County, Indiana, who was a councilman of the Second Ward in Clarks Hill, Indiana.

Lola's parents, George and Amanda Sowerwine, were prominent members of Wilkinson in Hancock County, Indiana. Mr. Sowerwine was born near Cicero on February 9, 1851. Mrs. Sowerwine was born near Wilkinson on October 29, 1854. Mr. Sowerwine had been a merchant, banker, and postmaster for over sixty years.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The collection contains two photo albums and several photographs of Hallie Yeoman-Cooley and her family. Among the photographs is a carte de visite from the Civil War of Isaac P. Foland of the 34th Indiana Regiment, 1863. The collection also contains two autograph books and a record book from Hallie's senior year at Ambia High School. There are also cards, a marriage certificate, a family genealogy, and other miscellaneous papers. Most of the news clippings and photos are related to Hallie's family, the township, wartime news, and stories on the death of actress Carole Lombard.
