#### HISTORICAL SKETCH

The collection contains an unpublished typed history titled *Indiana Courthouses*. The essays are for the courthouses for the counties of Harrison, Marion, Wayne, Ripley, Switzerland, Jefferson, Decatur, Orange, and Posey and are accompanied by copy photographs.
