BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Members of the Frank and Anna Newport family occupied the home at 4218 Cornelius Avenue, Indianapolis, from ca. 1918 to ca. 1962. The address first appears in the 1918 Indianapolis city directory. The principal householders, as listed in Indianapolis directories, were: Anna Newport (widow of Frank Newport), ca. 1918–ca. 1925; Frank B. Newport, ca. 1925–ca. 1928; Earl F. Newport (musician), ca. 1928–ca. 1934; Frank B. Newport, ca. 1936-ca. 1942; Anna M. Newport, ca. 1942–ca. 1960; and Earl F. Newport, ca. 1960–ca. 1962.
