BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

The George Coultis Family lived at 945 Congress Street in Indianapolis, Indiana, in 1905, and at 4145 Central Avenue from ca. 1914 to ca. 1924. George Coultis was treasurer and later vice-president of the J. S. Cruse Realty Company. Daughters Helen and Dorothy Coultis graduated from Shortridge High School in 1920 and 1922, respectively. The Coultis family is not listed in *Polk's Indianapolis Directory* after 1924.
