### **BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH**

John R. Haulenbeck enlisted as a private in the Union Army in May 1861. He was mustered into G Company in the New Jersey 2<sup>nd</sup> Infantry. He was discharged for disability on 16 December 1862. He re-enlisted on 28 June 1863 and was mustered into the New Jersey 1<sup>st</sup> Militia Infantry. He was mustered out one month later.
