### **BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH**

Martin Barley enlisted in April 1862 as a corporal. He was placed in Company A, of the 5<sup>th</sup> Indiana Cavalry (90<sup>th</sup> Regiment, Indiana Volunteers) on 4 August 1862. He was eventually promoted to full sergeant. He was mustered out on the 15<sup>th</sup> of June 1865.
