HISTORICAL SKETCH

The Indianapolis Press Club was incorporated 10 April 1934, "not for pecuniary profit," and for the following purposes:

"to promote the social enjoyment among its members, and to encourage and foster the ethical standards of the newspaper profession."

The Club had several predecessors, notably a Press Club founded in 1890 which lasted for some twenty-five years and listed among its members not only newspaper writers (including four women) but local literary figures such as James Whitcomb Riley, Meredith Nicholson, and historian Jacob Piatt Dunn. It had rooms on the second floor of the Claypool Hotel.

The 1934 Club immediately looked for rooms in which the "social enjoyment" of its members could be promoted, a bar being essential for the purpose. Such rooms were found, first in the basement of Mike Hanrahan's Bar at 23 North Pennsylvania Street (1934-1935), then in rooms above the Pretzel Bell Tavern at 117 North Illinois Street, (1935-1937), then on the third floor of the Journal Building at 48 Monument Circle. Two fires in 1953 necessitated vacating the premises on the Circle and moving to Jerry's Cabaret at 136 West Market Stret. After three years there, the Club made arrangements to occupy the penthouse of the new Indiana State Teachers Association building at the northeast corner of Capitol and Market Streets. When this building was remodelled in 1988, the Club moved from the penthouse to the basement.

To begin with the Club was restricted to male newspapermen. In 1941 Sheriff Al Feeney became the first representative of a new class of members not newspapermen but "deemed by the board to be an asset to the club." Membership has been extended to members of the legislature when it is in session. It took quite a while for radio journalists to achieve equality in the club; their first representative was elected president in 1969. In that same year full membership was extended to female journalists, and the first woman president served seven years later. The membership list has expanded over the years from forty-one to over seven hundred.

Along with maintaining a restaurant and bar, the Club has made a point through the years of providing parties and entertainments. Of these, the most elaborate, and the most reliable source of income, has been the yearly Gridiron Dinner, which began in 1947. Modelled after the event given by the National Press Club in Washington, D. C., the Gridiron "roasts" a number of political figures, and includes an elaborate program and often a joke edition of a newspaper. Other frequent events have been Front Page Balls, Inflation Nights, and Old Timers' Nights. There have also been golf tournaments, 500-Mile Race parties, and movie premieres.

Scholarships have been given to deserving students entering Indiana colleges. At one period prizes were given for excellence in news coverage. There have also been prizes for creative writing.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

This collection, filling sixteen manuscript boxes and two oversize boxes, contains minutes, correspondence, programs, scripts, and photographs. It is arranged by function.

<u>Box 1</u> contains historical material (<u>Folders 1, 6-8</u>), articles and bylaws (<u>Folders 2-5</u>), Club election results (<u>Folders 15-19</u>), and publications: newsletters (<u>Folders 22-24</u>) and a Club history, *Dateline Indiana*, published in 1958 (<u>Folders 25-32</u>). Portraits of Club presidents are stored in Visual Collectins.

Boxes 2-3 contain board minutes and correspondence, 1936-1983. Financial data are in Boxes 4 and 5 and in OMB 48 Box 1.

In <u>Box 6</u> are material on Club scholarships (<u>Folders 1-9</u>) and on a fund-raising effort in 1979 (<u>Folders 10-13</u>); also ABC licenses 1937-1972 (<u>Folders 14-16</u>).

Boxes 7-11 contain membership applications, 1934-1980.

<u>Boxes 12-15</u> contain material about the Club's Gridiron Dinners. Programs are in <u>Box 12</u>, and joke newspapers in <u>OMB 48 Box 2</u>. Several roastmasters' scripts are in <u>Box 13</u>. Correspondence and other Gridiron material are in <u>Boxes 14-15</u>. <u>Box 16</u> contains material about other Club entertainments.

In <u>Box 17</u> (stored in Visual Collections) are photographs of Club parties and other events. Identification of people and events in these photgraphs was based largely on the advice of longtime member James E. Farmer. There are also some original cartoons by local cartoonists, some once used as decorations in the Club headquarters.
