HISTORICAL SKETCH

The Indianapolis Model Cities Program was an outgrowth of a 1966 Congressional Act called the Demonstration Cities and Metropolitan Development Act. This Act provided financial assistance for cities which wanted to solve neighborhood problems with new ideas and local agencies. In 1968 Mayor Richard G. Lugar began work on a Model Cities Program for Indianapolis. First a Planning and then an Action Grant was approved and funded by the Federal Government. The Model Cities program began in 1970. After lasting only one year it was terminated in 1971.

This collection was donated in honor of Raymond Lewis Garmel who was born, 14 March 1918, in Brooklyn, New York. During the 1960's he was a city planner with the Washington D.C. mayors office. In 1969 Garmel was hired by Lugar as Planning Director of the Model Cities Program and served until it ended in 1971. He subsequently worked at the Veterans Administration Hospital as a Benefits Councilor. Raymond Garmel passed away 5 February 1986 in Indianapolis, Indiana.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The abbreviation CDA stands for the City Demonstration Agency; the CDA-UMIS is the City Demonstration Agency - Unified Management Information System.
