### **BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH**

<u>Franklin Blair</u> (1859-1907) was born in Princeton, Indiana, the son of Dr. William W. Blair and Margaret Warnock. He graduated from Jefferson Medical College in Philadelphia in 1884, and the following year began to practice medicine in Princeton in partnership with his father. He studied in Vienna in 1889. In the year of his death he was a principal mover in incorporating the Princeton Sanitarium.
