Frederick S. Wysong (d. 1863) was a resident of Germantown, Indiana (Wayne Co.). He enlisted in the 6th Indiana Regiment in April 1861. In August 1861, he re-enlisted and received a commission as captain of the 8th Regiment, Company D. He was killed at Vicksburgh, Mississippi, on May 22, 1863.
