HISTORICAL SKETCH

Wayne County was organized in 1810. The first county seat was at Salisbury. In 1816 the county seat was moved to Centerville, and remained there until a final move was made to Richmond in 1873.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

This collection consists of one bound folio volume of records of court judgments between 1826 and 1839, when the county seat was in Centerville. Suits involve such matters as gambling, retailing without license, divorce, assault and battery, and bastardy. A first section, dated 1826-1831, lists the name, citation, and type of case, as well as the judgment. A second section, dated 1831-1839, lists only the amount of the judgment, the name of the case, and the date.
