HISTORICAL SKETCH

George Hitz, Jr. (11 September 1911-) was born in Anderson, Indiana. His father joined the Anderson Golf Club in 1909 and young George learn to play golf at an early age. He played on the Anderson High School golf team from 1927-1929. In 1929 Anderson High School won its first state golf championship at Logansport. After high school, Hitz

attended Purdue University for 3 1/2 years. He retired from Delco Remy as manager of purchasing.
