**BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH**

Albert Holmes (1881-1968) lived in Harrison Township, Owen County, Indiana. In his youth he attended school and Baptist church at Little Mount in Wayne Township, near Gosport.

The first school-church building at Little Mount was a log cabin with greased paper windows, erected about 1825. The church congregation, at first led by John Mugg, was originally Hardshell Baptist, but later changed to Missionary Baptist. A new church and school building was put up in 1840, and a cemetery was established about ten years later. From this Little Mount Baptist church grew later congregations in Gosport, Quincy, and Samaria.
