BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Albert Irving Switzer was born on 14 May 1888 to Jacob Switzer and Mary Ellen Nagle in Otterbein, Indiana. He worked as a farmer. Albert married Frances Elvira Smith on 10 February 1913 in Fowler, Indiana. They had three children, William Spencer, Alberta I., and Francis Lorraine. Albert died on 6 September 1956 in Tippecanoe County, Indiana.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

This collection contains papers and materials which belonged to Albert Irving Switzer. Included is Switzer's account ledger from 1934 through 1942. Materials originally laid in the ledger consist of miscellaneous tags for a Wagner repulsion-induction motor, and day calendar sheets with handwritten notes. Also in the collection are two warranty deeds from 1916 and 1939, a quit claim deed from 1952, an 1877 Indianapolis City Court receipt for Albert Peake, a freight receipt, and a letter written by L. Rawlings dated 24 July 1886. Finally, the collection contains four Tomlinson & Co Bank checks from the 1880s. One was used as note paper. The other three were signed by J.P. McCormack.
