Aldo J. Simpson was born August 4, 1892 in Millersburg, IN to Edward H. and Arvilla Juday Simpson. Aldo grew up in Elkhart County and attended school there. On June 20, 1917 Aldo married Mae R. Chiddister, who passed away December 14, 1937. They had two sons, James and Richard. Aldo was a member of the Indiana National Guard from 1924 to 1926. He became a member of the U.S. Sons of the American Revolution in 1952.
