#### **BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH**

Archie Broadus Pace was born 27 February 1896 in Alabama. Archie served in the U.S. Army from May 1919 until May 1920. Archie married Julia Eleanor Poindexter and they had a son, Robert Pace, born 10 December 1921. The family lived in Speedway, Indiana. Archie worked as a supervisor and mechanic in the automobile industry throughout his life. and Julia was a stenographer. Archie traveled through Europe for his job at the Stutz Motor Company, based in Indianapolis, in the late 1920s and early 1930s. Archie died 15 November 1977.
