HISTORICAL SKETCH

Billings General Hospital was constructed on the grounds of Fort Benjamin Harrison, east of Indianapolis and opened on 1 March 1941 under the command of Colonel Harry L. Dale. It was named for Colonel John Straw Billings from Switzerland County, Indiana, who served as a surgeon during the Civil War, and was on the staff of the Army Surgeon General from 1864–1895. Its primary function was to serve as an orthopedic center for wounded soldiers. The hospital was designed to house 1,600 patients but at times the number swelled to 2,000. The hospital closed in March, 1946.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The collection contains scrapbooks, photographs, and patient interviews, 1941–1946. Martha R. Baum, a civilian with the hospital's public relations staff assembled the scrapbooks and conducted the patient interviews. The scrapbooks are comprised of photographs, newspaper clipping and other items chronicling the history of the hospital. Patient interviews include basic information and are separated into two categories: alphabetical and by type such as branch of service, where served, prisoners, nurses and African-Americans. Also included are photographs of military personnel receiving treatment and performing rehabilitation exercises. There also are photographs of parties, dances, and special events including performances and visits by celebrities including Bob Hope and Bing Crosby, Carmen Miranda and Jennifer Jones. Additional items include loose newspaper clippings, copies of the hospital's newsletter, *Top Billings*, a record book of newspaper releases, and general items regarding the hospital.
