## **BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH**

Daniel B. Sutton (1816–1901) was born in Greene, Ohio, and married Mary J. Roberts (1815–1898) around 1835. The Suttons moved to Red Key, Jay County, Indiana around 1845, but were living in Richland, Jay County, Indiana by the 1840s. After living for a short time in Delaware County, Sutton returned to Red Key where he died in 1901.
