BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Edward J. Vadas of Cedar Lake, Indiana created this collection with the intention of writing a book on Indiana Courthouses entitled *Photographic Survey on the County Courthouses in Indiana*. Mr. Vadas wrote to county historical societies and libraries in 1978 requesting information on the courthouses. His book was never published but his research materials and photographs are preserved in this collection.

This collection was created by Edward J. Vadas during his research for a book on Indiana courthouses. The materials include correspondence, research notes, and photographs made by him.
