BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Elias Brady (1837–11 December 1863) was born in Montgomery County, Indiana, and later moved to Rainsville in bordering Warren County, Indiana. In 1859 he married Martha Gap and they had one child. Brady enlisted as a musician in Co. D of the 86th Indiana Regiment in August, 1862. He died on 11 December 1863 after the regiment had been engaged at the Battle of Lookout Mountain.
