BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Obediah Kittle (O.K.) Stevens was born around 1845 in Indiana. O.K. married Martha Miller and they had several children, including Elmer, Charles, James, Margaret (Maggie), and Harriet (Hattie).

O.K's son, Elmer Arbie Stevens, was born 9 February 1871 in Indiana. Elmer married Mary Moore. Together they had several children, including Linnie, Martha, India, and Elmer Arbie Jr. The family lived in several places, such as Torrance County, New Mexico and Palo Pinto County, Texas. Elmer Sr. died 1 February 1957.

Elmer Sr.'s daughter, Martha, was born around 1905 in New Mexico. Martha married Fred Morrison O'Dell. They had two children, Charles Elmer and Hazel Leona. Martha later married Homer Hatfield. They had several children, including Geneva, Dorothy, Elverta, and William. Martha's daughter, Hazel O'Dell, married Wilfred Kennedy in August 1945.
