BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Fay Welch was born 2 January 1890 in Maysville, Kentucky to Thomas D. and Kate A. Glascock. The family moved to Indiana around 1893. Fay's mother died and her father placed her with John and Mary Elizabeth Bowman to be raised beginning in October 1895. The Bowman's lived near Wallace, Indiana. Fay married Jim Welch on 3 January 1909. They lived near Deer's Mill, Indiana and had one daughter in 1909. Jim died on 14 September 1937 of Rocky Mountain spotted fever. Fay died 30 December 1973.
