## **BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH**

George Clyde Burkert (1878-1964) was born in Germantown, OH to Cyrus and Anna Burkert. In 1904 Burkert married Ruth Markley. Together they had three children, Anna Louise (1906), Alice (1908), and George Cyrus (1912). Burkert worked as a travelling salesman, and the family resided in Richmond, IN.

Ruth's father, John Armstrong Markley, was a Civil War veteran. Markley was born in Pennsylvania, later moving to East Germantown, IN. Along with Ruth, Markley and wife Mary C. had four other children, Edith, Alice, Scott, and John. Edith married Fred C. Lahrman. A portrait of their son Carl (1910) is included in the collection. They lived in Richmond, Indiana. A great grandson of John A. Markley was gifted minutes of the "Old Brigade" and, with others, began expounding upon activities and research of the "Old Brigade."
