BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

George W. Wright (born 1853) was born in Hamilton County, Indiana, the son of Jesse W. Wright, a prosperous farmer of Wayne Township, and Ann Aldred Wright. In the 1890s and early 1900s Wright operated a firm in Lapel, Indiana, which manufactured gas regulators, boiler feeders, and force pumps.
