BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Harley W. Rhodehamel was born 6 December 1884 to John Rhodehamel and Emma Jose. Harley graduated from Purdue University in 1907. On 5 February 1910, he married Mary Klentschy. They had two children, Robert and Harley Jr. Harley worked as a chemist. In 1928, he was the director of the research division at Lilly Research Laboratories. Harley died on 8 April 1952.
