BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Henry C. Brown (1838–1907) was born in Lancaster, Pennsylvania. Brown and his family soon moved to Allen County, Indiana. In 1859 Henry Brown married Elizabeth Johnson and moved to Otter Creek, Ripley County, Indiana. In August, 1862, he enlisted as a first sergeant in Company G of the 85th Indiana Regiment. Brown was promoted to second lieutenant in April, 1863, and to first lieutenant in January, 1865. After mustering out in June, 1865, Brown and his family moved to Richland County, Wisconsin, where he farmed.
