SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

This collection includes field notes on the Calumet River and boundary lines on letterhead of the Office of the Auditor of State, Indiana. Included is a document recording the sale of swamp lands from the State of Indiana to Ernest W. Hohman in exchange for \$37.88, dated 3 February 1854. On the reverse of this document is another record of the sale of lands to George Dalton in exchange for \$61.88, dated 23 January 1889. The collection also contains another document granting Ernest W. Hohman a deed from the State of Indiana for his purchase of swamp lands, dated 6 November 1854.
