BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Jacob B. Rhodes was born in 1829. He married Mary Jane Cole in 1851, and together they had six children: Alice, Alene, Robert, Walter, Olivia, and Matthew. Rhodes was a Reverend and farmer, primarily residing in the Crawford and Harrison counties, Indiana. He died in 1904 and was buried in Milltown, Indiana.
