BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

James D. Williams, a resident of Indianapolis, worked as a volunteer for the Indiana State Welfare Department in 1984. During the summer of that year he wrote "Public Welfare in Indiana: A Brief History." Later that year the book was published by the Welfare Department in an edited and shortened version as The Evolution of Indiana's Public Welfare System. This version omitted much of the material in the original about conditions and programs in the 19th

and early 20th centuries. Williams later worked with the Indiana Youth Services Association.
