BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

James Willigman was born around 1842 in Maryland. He moved to Warren, Tuscarawas, Ohio, around 1860 and was residing in Sugar Ridge, Clay County, Indiana by 1865. On 8 February, 1865, James enlisted in the Indiana Volunteers as a private of Company B, 149th Indiana Regiment. He was honorably discharged on 27 September, 1865, in Nashville, Tennessee. Willigman may have moved to Wright County, Minnesota, by 1870.
