BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

John Gregory (ca 1844 - ca 1910) was the son of B. F. Gregory, a substantial citizen of Williamsport, Indiana-- county treasurer, owner of a quarry and a textile mill, recruiter of Union troops for the Civil War, vocal Republican and temperance man. In 1870, John Gregory bought the *Warren [County] Republican*, the party organ, and ran it for forty years. He, too, was a temperance man; he also served as reporter for the Knights of Honor.
