HISTORICAL SKETCH

In 1998, an Indiana Heritage Research Grant (IHRG) sponsored by the Tippecanoe County Historical Association in Lafayette, Indiana provided for the salvage, study, processing, and inventory of the Kethtippecanunk collection. This collection, housed at the Tippecanoe Battlefield Museum in Battle Ground, Indiana, included artifacts and maps from both amateur and professional surface collection, test excavation, and a proton magnetometer survey from 1974 to the late 1980s.
