## **BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH**

The Lee Chapple Temperance Society of La Otto, Noble County, Indiana was started in February 1870 with Lewis Holbrook serving as chairman and E. S. Harrison serving as secretary. It was later referred to as the "Gospel Temperance Society of La Otto, Noble Co." The organization continued to meet into the 1880s. The minutes state it was an auxiliary of the Congressional Union Temperance Society of Washington, D. C.
