## **BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH**

Lycurgus Irwin (listed as Lycurgis in the Adjutant General's official reports) was a resident of Putnam County, Indiana. On June 14, 1861, he enlisted as a First Sergeant in Company F of the 15<sup>th</sup> Indiana Volunteer Infantry. He served with the regiment for its entire tour of service and was promoted to 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieutenant on March 9, 1863. He mustered out with the rest of the regiment in Indianapolis, Indiana on June 16, 1864.
