**BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH**

Boaz was a Baptist minister in Bartholomew County, Indiana (1818–46).

**SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE**

The bulk of the collection consists of business and tax receipts of Boaz and his son, Simeon Boaz (d. ca. 1895), a farmer in Bartholomew County. The collection also includes papers relating to the settlement of Mignon Boaz's estate; a license to preach in Harrison County (1819); and a notebook of family information (1733–1814) kept by Boaz's father-in-law Elijah Pope, a Baptist minister in South Carolina and Bartholomew County.
