BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Charles Wright Milhous, 1858-1939, was the fifth child of Quakers Joshua Vickers Milhous and Elizabeth Price Milhous. He owned a drugstore called Milhous Drugs in Seymour, Indiana, from the 1880s until moving to Orange County, California, around 1912. By 1913, Elizabeth Price Milhous, her children, and their families had all moved to the Quaker community near Whittier, Los Angeles County, California.

Charles is credited as the photographer of many of the images in the collection. Although many of the individuals in the images are not identified, the following is a list of people who could be pictured and their relation to Charles Wright Milhous (organized by family group).

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

For each image, the print and plate locations are notated. Please access the prints or digital images whenever possible.

The glass plate negatives were originally organized into nine packets and are stored in these groupings with original notations. For ease of access, copy prints were made and are grouped into subject folders.

Images consulted in the genealogy (*Descendants of William Milhous, Jr. and Martha Vickers*, compiled by Eloise Price, 199-?) are noted.

Series 1: Butlerville, Jennings County, Indiana

Butlerville, Indiana is where much of the Milhous family grew up and lived.

Series 2: Seymour, Jackson County, Indiana

These images are scenes Charles Wright Milhous photographed while he lived in Seymour, Indiana.

Series 3: Indiana—“Old House” in Seymour, Jackson County

Charles Wright Milhous and his family lived in this house in Seymour prior to 1902.

Series 4: Indiana—“New House” in Seymour, Jackson County

Charles Wright Milhous moved to a “new, grander” house in Seymour around 1902.

Series 5: Indiana—Ola Glen McClure Farm, Vienna, Scott County

Ola Glen McClure was the sister of Rose McClure Milhous, wife of Charles Wright Milhous. She and other members of the McClure family were photographed by Charles.

Series 6: McClure Family in Scott County, Indiana

Members of the McClure family possibly were photographed because they were Charles Wright Milhous’ in-laws.

Series 7: California—House of Charles Wright Milhous

The house Charles Wright Milhous and his family moved into in California.

Series 8: California—“Hadley Home”

These images look similar to a house in the genealogy captioned the “Hadley Home”, referring to Lewis Isaac Hadley and his wife Edith Griffith Milhous (sister of Charles Wright Milhous).

Series 9: California

Images taken by Charles Wright Milhous while in California.

Series 10: Child’s Funeral

Images taken during a child’s funeral, possibly in Indiana.

Series 11: Miscellaneous

The location and subjects of these images are largely unknown and therefore grouped together.
