Orin (or Orren) B. Cutler was born around 1835 and resided in Madison, Jefferson County, Indiana. On August 15, 1861 he enlisted in the Indiana Volunteer as a 1st Class Musician of Company K, 22nd Regiment. He was discharged June 20, 1862.
