BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Ransom P. Holmes bought a piece of property in Jackson County, Indiana, in 1849, and in 1856 subscribed for stock in the Ohio and Mississippi Rail Road Company. His name does not appear in available county histories.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

This collection contains four items, dated 1849-1861. The first two are related to Ransom P. Holmes: an 1849 deed of land to Holmes by Abraham and Elizabeth Compton; and an 1856 certificate that Holmes has subscribed \$2.88 for stock in the Ohio and Mississippi Rail Road.

The third item is an 1857 Green County deed from Drury Boyd to Zacahariah Morgan. The fourth is a survey of lots laid out near the junction of the Muscatatuck River with the East Branch of White River (in Driftwood Township, Jackson County, just south of Medora).
