HISTORICAL SKETCH

Frank O'Bannon, 30 January 1930 – 13 Sept. 2003, was born in Corydon, Indiana, and attended Indiana University. O'Bannon, a Democrat, served as the 47th Governor of Indiana from January 13, 1997 until his death on September 13, 2003. Prior to that, he was Lieutenant Governor from January 9, 1989 to January 13, 1997 under Evan Bayh. He was also a member of the Indiana Senate from 1970–1989. Prior to entering politics, O'Bannon practiced law in Corydon and was the editor of the Corydon *Democrat*.

Joe Kernan (8 April, 1946 –) was Lieutenant Governor of Indiana from January 13, 1997 until Governor Frank O'Bannon's passing on September 13, 2003. Kernan filled the Governor role until the end of the term on January 10, 2005. He was not reelected and retired from politics. He served as the mayor of South Bend, Indiana before he was Lieutenant Governor. He served in that role from 1988 to 1997. Kernan served in the U.S. Navy and was a prisoner of war for eleven months in North Vietnam from 1972–1973.

RealMed Corporation is a healthcare company designed to provide revenue cycle management solutions for the health care industry. They provide a number of management services. It was founded in 1995 and is based out of Indianapolis, Indiana.
