#### **BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH**

Shiloh Graves was originally from Irvington, Indiana. She graduated from Arsenal Technical High School in 1962. In August 1964 Graves married Masao Shimura, a Japanese college teacher. They moved to Fujisawa-shi, Japan in 1966 and had three children, Paul, Wendy Akagi, and Anne Mia. Shiloh taught English to housewives at her local community center. She also practiced reiki, a healing technique where the practitioner lays their hands on a person to channel healing energy to them.
