HISTORICAL SKETCH

The Stutz Motor Car Company of America was founded by Harry Clayton Stutz in Indianapolis in 1911 as the Ideal Motor Car Company. Following the company's success, Stutz renamed it after himself in 1913. After a period of economic decline caused by the Great Depression, the company closed its doors and ceased manufacturing in 1937.

The Stutz Series AA was unveiled at the New York Automobile Show on January 9, 1926. According to the 1927 Stutz Handbook for Sales, the new car was the main attraction of the show, drawing crowds of people. The engine was initially offered in six different models, each listed for \$2,995. The number of 1926 Series AA cars produced and/or sold is estimated at 3,692 to 5,000.
