BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

After graduating from Illinois University and a stint an the Illini Publishing Company, in 1934 Victor L. Krannert moved to Indianapolis and began working with his brother, Herman C. Krannert at the company he founded: the Inland Box Company, which produced corrugated cardboard boxes. The company underwent a name change in the 1930, switching its name to the Inland Container Corporation.
