## **BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH**

O'Brien was born in Lawrenceburgh, Indiana in 1855. He attended Indiana Asbury University (DePauw). In 1877 he and William D. H. Hunter purchased the Lawrenceburgh Register, which they owned until 1894. O'Brien was elected mayor of Lawrenceburgh in 1885.
