Borden was a geologist, landowner, and farmer in New Providence (Clark County) and New Albany (Floyd County), Indiana.

The collection consists primarily of business and tax receipts of Borden and his mother, Lydia Borden (d. 1851). Also included are letters relating to family matters (1824, 1861).
