## **HISTORICAL SKETCH**

An Indiana Heritage Research Grant sponsored by the Woodlawn Nature Center in Elkhart, Indiana provided for the creation of an inventory of the center's Native American artifacts. The artifacts date from the Paleoindian period (around 30,000 to 10,000 years before the present) to the present. The grant also aided in the development of a new Native American exhibit at the nature center. The exhibit included dioramas with detailed narratives of the artifacts and their time periods as well as literature on Native American cultures.
