In 1909, Lewis Bundy began a feed mill in Vallonia specializing in flour. The current name was implemented when Lewis' brother, Otis, and their sons, were added to the business. Expanding to Medora in 1926, the new facility specialized in cornmeal that was hauled to several "business sites" in southern Indiana and Kentucky. These were long hauls and the driver was instructed to "ask no questions."

Bundy Bros. now sells feed, seed, fertilizer and chemicals to several counties in the southern part of the state. Leiland R. Bundy, Jr.'s sons, Larry and Mike Bundy, continue the friendly and efficient service that Bundy Bros. has become known to provide.
